Barracuda Yacht Design created the all-aluminium Atlantis Xcape 76 for a Spanish former fishing fleet owner who knows a thing or two about boats. The build of the unfussy yet indisputably handsome 23-metre family cruiser will be completed at the Atollvic Shipyard in Vigo, NW Spain, this summer. The owner is downsizing from larger yachts and wants to do most of the steering himself aboard this 22-knot craft. After a lifetime of working with the sea, he is also safety-conscious hence the ‘go-anywhere’ multi-chine hull has walk-around access and raised hand-rails. The interior has an apartment-

like feel with tall, panoramic windows in both superstructure and hull. Barracuda have provided lots of home comforts and made the yacht easy to move around too. The hull is well insulated against noise and vibration, while the main saloon, dining area and galley are all refreshingly spacious. A supersize Seakeeper gyro stabiliser holds the yacht steady both at anchor or at sea. Accommodation-wise, there are three full size guest cabins with wide-entry showers in both the VIP and Master but two single crew cabins also give the option of support for the owner. www.barracuda-yd.com
